## PACIFIC NORTHWEST ANTIQUE AIRCRAFT AIR TOUR

The Pacific Northwest Air Tour is coming to Kalispell on Tuesday, July 14th. Around thirty antique and classic airplanes will be arriving during the afternoon and will be departing Thursday morning around 8 AM.

The Puget Sound Antique Airplane Club is organizing the air tour. The objective of the Air Tour is to recreate the historic barn storming tours of the 1930's that brought aviation appreciation to communities across the nation. A sampling of planes include: Pre-war Howards, and Interstates; Stearman and Fairchild military trainers; and numerous post war Aeronca, Beechcraft, Bellanca, Cessnas, Piper and Taylorcraft aircraft.

Area business such as the newly renovated GuestHouse Inn and the Montana Trolley Co. locally owned by Scott Davis (and daughter DawnD) benefit by providing services required by flyers into Kalispell City Airport. Red Eagle Aviation will provide FBO services at the city owned airport.

The public is invited to come out and view these remarkable planes and meet the pilots during their stay at the Kalispell City Airport.

The tour will begin in Richland, Wa. and make stops in St Maries, Id., Bonners Ferry Id., and Crystal Lakes, Mt. prior to arriving in Kalispell. The tour aircraft will be departing Kalispell for stops in Kamiah, Id. and Lewiston, Id.
