Seattle and got a job at Puget Sound Flight Center at Boeing Field (where Aero Flight is now). When the company went out of business, I was offered a job by some of my former students who owned Holiday Foods. I took the job and became a meat cutter. After a year I started a flight school at Boeing Field while continuing to work as a meat cutter. It was called Flight Tech, which I was the owner and flight instructor. After four years, I sold the business and started working for San Juan Airlines. I worked there for one and a half years. During the time I was flying a single pilot Cessna 402. When I had to fly IFR to Canada, it was required to have two pilots, so I would fly to Friday Harbor and pick up Ernie Gann. (In 1966 Ernie purchased an 800-acre ranch on San Juan Island.) Ernie, who never liked to be called Mr. Gann, was a funny person and I learned a lot from him about flying.

I took a job at Horizon Air flying a Fairchild Metroliner SA227 for 6 months then moved onto World Airways where I was a Boeing 727 Flight Engineer for 3 months then was furloughed. I then obtained a job at Wings West flying a Fairchild Metroliner SA227 again. After 1 year 3 months I finally got my dream job: working for the largest airline, United. I have been there for 24 years. First I was a flight engineer on the Boeing 727 for a year then First Officer and now Captain for 16 years, currently flying the 757/767's.

I have flown Boeing 737, 757, and 767's.

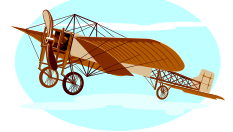
Elections will be held at the

BY LAWS

of the

PUGET SOUND

ANTIQUE AIRPLANE CLUB

Article IV

Meetings

Section 1. There shall be a minimum of **six** general meetings of the members of the organization. Special meetings may be called at any time by the Board of Directors or the President or upon written request of not less than fifteen members. The time and place of such regular and special meetings shall be designated by the President and the Secretary shall give written notice of such time and place to each member at least five days before such meeting.

Section 2. Members shall be entitled to vote by written proxy.

Section 3. A quorum of members of the club shall consist of 15% of members entitled to vote.
